Book Fair - an opportunity to buy cheap books after school and raise funds to buy books for the school **Carols by Candlelight** – a celebration of Christmas at Grace Church

Christmas and Summer Fair - our most important fund raising events of the year in December and in June, all pupils, parents, carers, family members and friends are welcome

Class Assembly - a chance for all the family to come and see what the pupils have been learning in class

Coffee Morning- There is a coffee morning organised by parents in the Learning Lab on the first Friday of each month. This is very informal and provides parents and carers with a chance to get to know each other better; everyone is warmly invited.

DBS Clearance – Disclosure Barring Service, a must if you want to help on trips or events in school on a regular basis

District Sports - a half day of sporting competition at The Spectrum against local schools

Facebook – a private group for staff to share information and updates of the pupil's learning

Forest School - outdoor learning in the school grounds or the local area

GDPR (General Data Protection Regulations) - how we use and protect you and your child's data

Harvest - a celebration of the time of the year in the UK when crops are harvested

Heads Meeting - an opportunity to meet the Headteacher and find out the school priorities for the year

HSLW - the school has a Home School Link Worker who can help with any help that families and pupils may have that can be emotional, financial etc.

INSET Day – (In Service Training Day) a day when school is closed for staff training

Jolly Jars - a clean jar that is decorated and filled with wrapped sweets or other small items that is used on the children's tombola stall at fairs

EYFS – Pupils in Early Years Foundation Stage (Reception Class)

KS1 – Key Stage 1 (Pupils in Year 1 and Year 2)

KS2 – Key Stage 2 (Pupils in Year 3, 4, 5, & 6)

KS1 Birthday Assembly - you will receive an invitation to celebrate your child's birthday on a Thursday afternoon

KS2 Production – a production involving KS2 pupils with most of the main parts by the Year 6 class. Also involving the school choir and other KS2 pupils helping behind the scenes including backdrops, scenery, music, props.

Learning Journals – Given to each pupil to record their reading and space to communicate with your child's class teacher

LSA – Learning Support Assistant, a member of staff that works one-to-one with a pupil with specific needs

Meet the Teacher - a meeting at the beginning of the Autumn term to meet your child's class teacher

Mufti - a day when pupils may come to school wearing their own clothes, usually for fund raising

Nativity - a performance of the story of the birth of Jesus by all the pupils in Key Stage 1

Newsletter – a message from the Headteacher and information about the curriculum and events at Sandfield that is sent out once a month

Parents Evening – a 10 minute meeting with your child's class teacher to discuss progress and targets

Parent Rep - a parent volunteer from the class who helps organise class events and sends reminders

Pink Slips – a way of letting your child's class teacher know any daily messages, available in the office

SENDCo - a member of staff who is responsible for Special Educational Needs in the school

Sports Day - a whole morning where all pupils take part in various sporting events

Sports Week – a week of sporting events at Sandfield, pupils wear their P.E. kits all week

Snack Sale - the class bring in cakes, biscuits or healthy bites to sell to raise funds for the class

TA - Teaching Assistant, the member of staff that runs interventions and helps the class teacher
