

## SANDFIELD PRIMARY SCHOOL PROVISION MAP

There are 3 levels or 'waves' of provision that are provided to the pupils in the school.

Wave 1

 Quality first teaching - daily high level differentiated teaching delivered by class teacher for all pupils

Wave 2

 Short term targetted interventions for children who are not progressing with Wave 1 teaching.

Wave 3

 Long term support with personalised provision for children needing intensive support.

Each wave is broken down further into 4 categories of provision, these are:

Communication and Interaction

Social, Mental and Emotional Health
