

Reception Class

This week, we reflected on our journey in Reception so far. The children had time to reminisce about their favourite memories. This gave them an opportunity to appreciate their achievements and challenges they've overcome since September. Each child independently wrote about what they're good at now and what they'd like to improve on in the future; complete with capital letters, finger spaces and full stops!
