Staffing News for January 2025

As the Autumn Term comes to an end, we would like to take this opportunity to notify you of some upcoming staffing changes.

Sadly, at the end of this term, we will be saying a fond farewell to Mr Godber. He has been a very much valued member of the staff team for seven years and has played an important role in the development of Sandfield's whole school curriculum. He has led Computing and Maths across the school and we would like to take this opportunity to thank him for all that he has done. We will miss Mr Godber, and even some of his jokes, but take this opportunity to wish him every success as he moves onto his new school, closer to home.



From January, we welcome back Mrs Ledger, who will be teaching in Year 3 on Thursdays and Fridays. She already knows Sandfield well, as she worked as the Year 6 tutor last year. Mrs Ledger is a very experienced teacher and her expertise is working with children with SEND. Joining Mrs Ledger will be Mrs Malik. Mrs Malik has been teaching in Year 2 since joining Sandfield in September. She is an experienced Key Stage 2 teacher and will complete our Year 3 team.

In Year 2, replacing Mrs Malik, will be Mr Ney. He has a passion for reading and will bring his expertise from his previous career to support Computing in Key Stage 1. From January, the teaching team in Year 2 will be Miss McIllroy and Mr Ney, with Miss McIllroy teaching all day on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursday and Friday mornings. Mr Ney will be teaching on Thursdays and Fridays, leading in the afternoons. IMPORTANT Bromcom Rollout for Parents (MyChildAt School)

From January 2025, Sandfield and other schools in the Trust will be switching information systems from SIMs to Bromcom, parents will know this as **MyChildAtSchool or MCAS**.

Parents and carers will be able to access most school information in one place and also manage your child's data directly either from the portal on the **MCAS** Parent App and/ or from your desktop.

The **MCAS** App is available from Apple Store or from Google Play. You will be able to set any language you use, view your child's attendance, reports, book face-to-face Parents Evenings, receive push notifications and so on. The plan is that after Easter 2025 you will also be able to use **MCAS** to pay for trips, events, uniform etc. which will replace Scopay. We ask that all parents and carers sign up to **MCAS** by **the end of December 2024** so that you do not miss any information from school.
