Year 2 are working on being able to measure mass and recognise that different objects might weigh different amounts.

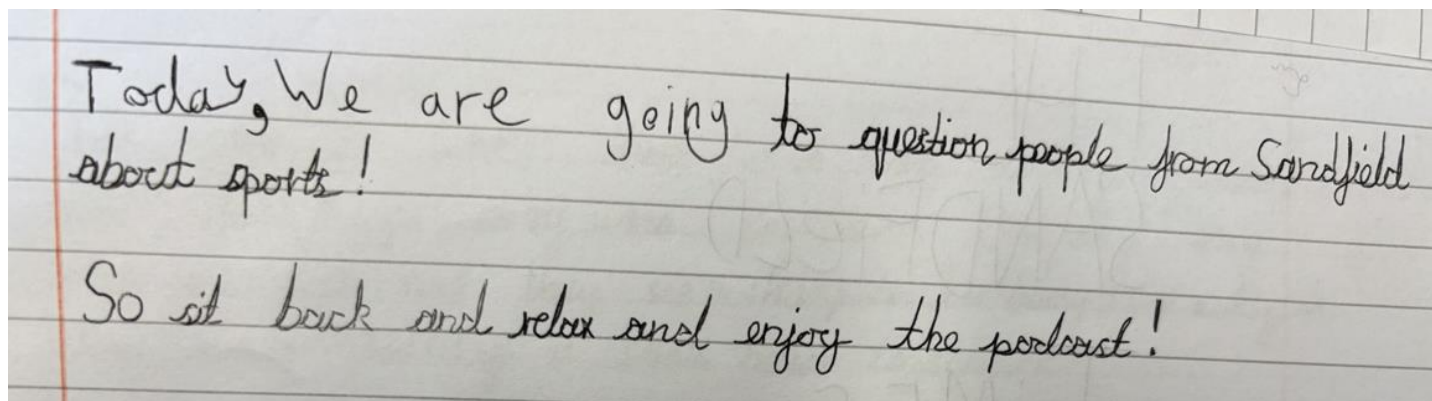
PE days for Year 1 & Year 2 are Mondays and Wednesdays
